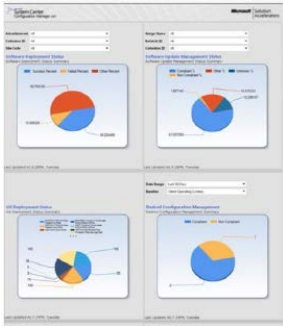

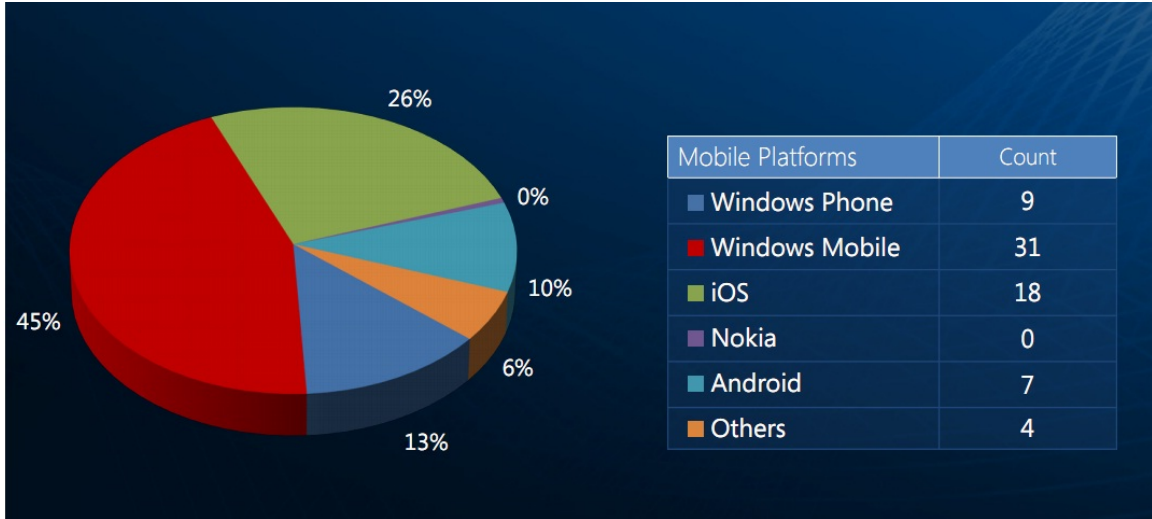
Enterprise Mobile Device & MAC OS X Management
